Teachers may elect to have students self-correct. The teacher collects assessment results to monitor individual student progress and to inform future instruction. Both student and teacher can quickly assess whether the student acquired the intended knowledge and skills. This is a formative assessment, so a grade is not the intended purpose.

In order to assess students a teacher must first decide what is to be taught. This requires setting long and short-term goals, choosing appropriate music to meet those goals, and then developing more specific learning objectives for each piece. The learning objectives are expressed in terms of what students will be able to do (SWBAT).

### Three Qualities of Effective Assessment of Student Learning

Classroom assessment techniques (CAT) are relatively quick and easy formative evaluation methods that help you check student understanding in "real time". These formative evaluations provide information that can be used to modify/improve course content, adjust teaching methods, and, ultimately improve student learning.
