Autoimmune blistering disorders are a group of rare skin diseases. They happen when your immune system attacks your skin and mucous membranes -- the lining inside your mouth, nose, and other parts ...

Other blistering disorders include staphylococcal scalded skin syndrome, toxic epidermal necrolysis, severe cellulitis, and certain drug rashes. Although burns and repeated friction (for example from wearing tight shoes or using a shovel for a long time) are a common cause of blisters, these are not considered blistering disorders.

In pemphigus diseases, the autoantibodies are directed against desmosomal proteins, and cell contact within the epidermis is lost.
