The general rule for deciding which ability scores (and corresponding T scores) to use is this: When you have a choice of two or more ability scores from different item sets, use the one with the smallest SEM . In this case, the ability score with the smaller SEM is from Item Set 1-16 (Ability Score = 95, SEM = 5).

For testing, the participants from the ages of 2-6 or 11-1 years must respond to 63 multiple-choice items.

Overview - Pearson Assessments
