Sleep Study Results. After your sleep study (polysomnogram or home sleep test) has been performed, there are 8 to 24 hours of data that need to be processed in order for it to be clinically useful. Scoring an arousal in a sleep study. According to the American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM), the patient must be asleep for at least 10 continuous seconds before an arousal can be scored. Also, a minimum of 10 continuous seconds of intervening sleep is needed to score a second arousal.
