Examine the dorsal surface of the heart (the side closest to your back). Locate the stumps of two relatively thin-walled blood vessels that enter the right atrium. Demonstrate this connection by passing a slender probe through them. The upper vessel is the superior vena cava, and the lower one is the inferior vena cava.

Dissecting a Pluck is a brilliant way for students to observe the how the lungs work and the heart in relation to the lungs.
