A single fin near the anus that keeps the fish upright and moving in a straight line. Anterior Dorsal Fin. Anterior single fin on the dorsal midline that keeps the fish upright and moving in a straight line. Caudal Fin. A single fin extending from the tail that moves side to side and propels fish forward.

perch are only slightly posterior and ventral to the pectorals. The entire, less pigmented ventral area is usually called the belly (not very scientific, but descriptive none-the-less). Fish Dissection Lesson Plan

After you put on gloves, and grab your tray, start by expanding your fish fins. Your fish is likely to have a pronounced and spiny dorsal fin (on top), pectoral fins (imagining chest level), a caudal fin (the tail), and an anal fin or two (in the back). Each one folds slightly differently.
