Most women can, but there are some instances in which an epidural may not be safe, including if you have certain bleeding disorders, take certain blood-thinning medications or suffer from specific spinal and neurological problems. Make sure to tell everyone -- nurses, anesthesiologist, and surgeon -- if you've ever had a problem with anesthesia before. Don't hesitate to repeat yourself. Myth: Epidurals can cause permanent back pain or paralysis in the mother. Fact: Serious complications from an epidural, including paralysis, are extremely rare. Delirium and excitation were frequent reactions when ketamine was introduced to practice in the early 1970s as a complete intravenous anesthetic agent and used without other hypnotics or sedatives.
