Manually (Offline) Update to Any Specific PS Vita Firmware

Connect your PS Vita system and the computer using a USB cable. On the PS Vita system, select (Settings) > [Start] > [System Update] > [Update by Connecting to a PC]. Your PS Vita system automatically checks over the Internet whether you have the latest version of the system software.

On your PS Vita, make sure to go into airplane mode in the settings. Launch QCMA from your PC, then plug in your PS Vita via USB. In the Vita's Settings, go to System Update, and Update from PC; Triple check that the update says Firmware 3.60, and nothing else (in particular not firmware 3.61/3.63, or anything above 3.60!) Update!

If your PS4 system software automatic download is stuck, please delete the update and start again: Select [Notifications] from the PS4 function area, highlight the update file and press the OPTIONS button > [Delete]. Next, select [Settings] > [System Software Update].

During an update, the power button on the system front and PS button of the controller are inactive. From the XMB™ menu, select (Settings) > (System Update), and then press the button. Select [Update via Internet], and then press the button. The system automatically searches for and finds the latest version of the update data.
