The Short Answer: Earth's tilted axis causes the seasons. Throughout the year, different parts of Earth receive the Sun's most direct rays. So, when the North Pole tilts toward the Sun, it's summer in the Northern Hemisphere. And when the South Pole tilts toward the Sun, it's winter in the Northern Hemisphere.

Why do the seasons change? So we know that the earth is spinning on its axis one full turn every 24 hours. At the same time, the earth is also moving around the sun in an elliptical or egg-shaped orbit that takes one full year or 365 days to complete.

As the Earth travels around the sun, this tilt causes different areas of the Earth's surface to get different amounts of daylight at different times of the year. The angle of the Sun's rays to the surface also causes areas to have more or less of the Sun's energy.

THE REASON FOR SEASONS

The seasons have nothing to do with how far the Earth is from the Sun. If this were the case, it would be hotter in the northern hemisphere during January as opposed to July. Instead, the seasons are caused by the Earth being tilted on its axis by an average of 23.5 degrees (Earth's tilt on its axis actually varies from near 22 degrees to 24.5 degrees).

What Causes the Seasons?

The changing position of the Earth's tilt is the reason for the differences in temperature and length of daylight that distinguish the seasons. When the Northern Hemisphere of the Earth is leaning toward the sun, it receives direct sunlight. The warmth of direct rays causes spring and then summer in that part of the globe.
