The Purpose of Building a Portfolio Assessment

Portfolio assessment is a term with many meanings, and it is a process that can serve a variety of purposes. A portfolio is a collection of student work that can exhibit a student's efforts, progress, and achievements in various areas of the curriculum. A portfolio assessment can be an examination of student-selected

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samples of work experiences and documents related to outcomes being assessed, and it can address and support progress toward achieving academic goals, including student efficacy.

Because the contents of portfolios are scored using specific criteria, the use of assessment portfolios is considered criterion-referenced assessment. Portfolios can provide a continuous picture of student progress, rather than a 3 snapshot of student achievement that single-occasion tests provide.

Portfolios can be a physical collection of student work that includes materials such as written assignments, journal entries, completed tests, artwork, lab reports, physical projects (such as dioramas or models), and other material evidence of learning progress and academic accomplishment, including awards, honors, certifications, recommendations, written evaluations by teachers or peers, and self-reflections written by students.
